

# 2026 New sign descriptions.

## Novice signs

**N36. Loop Right.** [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IXTPq1\\_HAho](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IXTPq1_HAho)

Moving together the team make a sharp turn to the right, crossing the original path. The angle of the turn is between 180 and 270.

**N37. Loop left.** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TRR1YWsWxXQ>

Moving together the team make a sharp turn to the left, crossing the original path. The angle of the turn is between 180 and 270.

**N38. Double 180 turn right then left** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Jii6MtB8-OE>

Moving together the team does a 180 turn to the right and moves in the opposite direction to that they were going. After 1-2 more steps the team turn 180 to the left.

**N39. Double 180 turn left then right.** <https://www.facebook.com/share/v/1NP4JwcXo2/>

Moving together the team does a 180 turn to the left and moves in the opposite direction to that they were going. After 1-2 more steps the team turn 180 to the right.

**N40 Offset serpentine left** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cCqP1qsb9ZE>

This sign requires three pylons. The center pylon will be offset to the left by 1m with the other two spaced approximately 2m apart. The dog and handler will enter into the weave with the first pylon on their left side. They must complete the entire serpentine together.

**N41. Offset serpentine right.** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1AjvVq1Fxi8>

This sign requires three pylons. The center pylon will be offset to the right by 1m with the other two spaced approximately 2m apart. The dog and handler will enter into the weave with the first pylon on their right side. They must complete the entire serpentine together.

## Advanced signs

**N58 (158) halt 1 step sit 2 steps stand 3 steps down.** <https://www.facebook.com/share/v/1NP4JwcXo2/>

The handler stops and the dog sits beside the handler. After that the handler takes one step forward and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a stand when the handler stops. The handler then takes two steps forward and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a sit when the handler stops. Thereafter the handler takes three steps forward and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a down when the handler stops. The dog stays down until the team moves forward.

**N59 (159) Stand 180 right stand** <https://www.facebook.com/share/v/1NP4JwcXo2/>

The handler stops and the dog stands beside the handler. Together the team does a tight 180° turn to the right on the spot, stops and the dog is directed to a stand position. The dog remains standing until the team moves forward.

**N60 (160) Stand 180 left stand** <https://www.facebook.com/share/v/1NP4JwcXo2/>

The handler stops and the dog stands beside the handler. Together the team does a tight 180° turn to the left on the spot, stops and the dog is directed to a stand position. The dog remains standing until the team moves forward.

## Excellent signs

**E62 (262) Call front 1 steps stand, 2 steps sit, 3 steps down**

The handler stops and the dog is directed to sit in front of the handler. After that the handler takes one step backwards and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a stand in front of the handler when the handler stops. The handler then takes two steps backwards and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a sit in front of the handler when the handler stops. Thereafter the handler takes three steps backwards and stops. The dog moves simultaneously with the handler and resumes a down in front of the handler when the handler stops. The dog is then directed to the handler's left side and the dog sits beside the handler. The dog remains sitting until the team moves forward.

**E63 (263) Two side steps right.** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TnqYiN9W9qU>

While heeling, the handler will take two side steps to the right, leading with the right foot, and continue heeling along the newly established line. The dog must move with the handler. This sign will be placed directly in line of the team's path requiring the dog and handler to side step to the right to pass the sign.

**E64 Cloverleaf** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PxKUw-7KTZ8>

This sign requires the cones to be spaced 2-3 apart. The dog and handler must complete the cloverleaf by crossing the center line four times. The first cone will be placed to the handlers left, and the dotted line indicates the entry and exit points for performance of this sign. This is a change of direction sign and upon exiting the team may go in any direction to the next sign.
